Arnaud Degousée, King of England

Since Sunday, Arnaud Degousée bears the title of Champion of England. Sacred to the end of the 3rd round at just 18 years, the pilot of Beynes, who dropped his schooling in terminal S, to the chagrin of his mother, to devote himself to his sport, and has offered his first major title in the elderly. And it doesn't stop there way. That son of a fairground entertainer, victim of the paternal virus at 8 - his first bike was waiting under the Christmas tree has in fact several goals in mind. Starting with the France Championship of Beach-cross which starts in three weeks at Loon-Plage (North), its main training venue.

"It may be more difficult because it generally runs faster in France, explains this racer on sand. But it will necessarily help me in my preparation for the Enduro of Le Touquet (Pas-de-Calais) in February."

The legendary event. Last year, Arnaud Degousée took the 5th place in Junior riding his TM 250 cm3, which had dropped to 100 meters of the finishing line when he left to finish on the podium. This time he is in the big league, on a Kawasaki 450 cm3, he will have to elbow in the middle of thousand participants.

"This is the toughest race in the world, he adds. I'm still missing a little experience when it comes to double the latecomers. The idea is to get into the top ten. I'm still where I want to improve myself on sand to become the best in France. Eventually, I want to win at Le Touquet."

A near-obsession. Other disciplines, yet most publicized and income, don't really passionate elsewhere. For now at least.

"I do supercross in training, but to really live on this, I would have to go to the United States, and I'm not ready yet, he explains. The rally didn't arm me. There is still too much data I can't control. If I was going to do the Dakar today, I would be able to kill me. It will rather be for the end of career."

In other words, not right away.
